

Glenburnie Park Circle Trip

Saturday, November 1st, 2008

WHEN: 10:00 a.m. depart / 2:00 p.m. return

WHERE: Meet at Glenburnie Park. To get to the park from U.S. 70 head north on Glenburnie Road (SR 43). Aprox. 2 miles turn right on Oaks Rd. and follow about .5 miles. Turn left on Glenburnie Drive to the end of the road. Bear left into park. Go past the playground on right and turn right to the J.C. pavilion and parking circle. Launch is on sandy beach at bottom of hill. Restrooms are available.

DIFFICULTY: Moderate due to distance (approx 6 miles) and some open waters (usually quite calm). November waters are beginning to cool down considerably so **“dress for success”** and bring a dry bag w/ spare clothing, food for **lunch** and h2o. Always **wear** your p.f.d.

TRIP DESCRIPTION: Some open river paddling w/ marsh islands to Cypress swamp. Birds and wildlife sightings likely.
