

# **Glenburnie Park**

## **Saturday, April 24, 2010 at 9:00 A.M.**

**When:** Saturday, April 24, 2010 – 9:00 A.M. We will try to be in the water by 9:30 A.M.

**Where:** Glenburnie Park at the JC Shelter Area.

**Directions:**

Go north on S. Glenburnie Rd. Cross Hwy 70. Cross Neuse Blvd. Continue about one mile to the stop light. Turn right to Oaks Road. Go about three blocks and turn left to Glenburnie Drive. (There is a sign on your right pointing out the way.) Continue about two blocks to the park. As you enter the park, keep to the left. Go up the hill and turn left through the yellow gates onto a dirt road. Go about on half a block and turn right at the JC Shelter and park.

**Paddle Distance:** About 5 miles up the Neuse River

**Trip Difficulty:** Moderate (depending on the weather)

**Skill Requirements:**

Novice unless the wind gets up. Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any reservations, contact your trip coordinator for advice.

**Provisions Needed:**

All paddlers please wear a suitable and approved PFD and dress accordingly. I suggest you bring water and maybe a snack. We should be on the water about two and one half hours. Back around 12:00 noon.
