

Oriental Wildlife Ramp

Saturday, June 19, 2010

WHEN: Saturday, June 19, 2010 at **9:00 A.M.**

WHERE: Meet at the NC Wildlife Ramp by 9:00 A.M.

PADDLE DISTANCE: approximately 5-6 miles

SKILL REQUIREMENTS: This trip is **appropriate for beginners** as long as wind conditions are below 10 to 15 miles per hour

TRIP DETAILS: We will meet at the Oriental Wild Life Ramp at 9:00 A.M., with a launch time of 9:30 A.M. We will paddle Smith Creek and Morris Creek and check out a couple of the Marinas.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: **PFD - All participants must wear their pfd at all times while in their vessel and afloat.** Some **water** and a **snack** are advised. Bring a **dry bag w/ some emergency clothing**, and a towel is always prudent. Avoid cotton ("**COTTON KILLS**").

LAUNCH: by 9:30 A.M.

TIME ON THE WATER: 3 to 4 hours max (should be off the water by 2 p.m.)
