

TRENT RIVER
Pollocksville to Riverbend
Saturday, May 26, 2007 at 10:00 am

WHEN: Saturday, May 26, 2007 - 10:00 a.m.
Launch no later than 10:30 a.m. and off water by 1:00 p.m.

WHERE: Pollocksville Wildlife Boat Ramp to Tar Landing in Riverbend
PADDLE DISTANCE: 7.5 miles

TRIP DIFFICULTY: ****EASY to MODERATE** (wind dependant)

SKILL REQUIREMENTS: ****STRONG BEGINNERS to INTERMEDIATE** (Call trip coordinator if you have questions about your ability.)

** Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any doubt, contact your trip leader for advice. TRPC membership not required however applications available at site.

TRIP DETAILS: Join other paddlers for an exploration paddle trip down the Trent River, starting at Pollocksville to Riverbend. We will follow Trent River exploring some of the side waterways along the way.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: A type II or III PFD must be worn and properly secured. Dress appropriately for weather conditions. Don't forget your lunch, sunscreen and plenty of water.

SHUTTLE: Paddlers, please plan to drop your boats off at Pollocksville and from there we will move a shuttle car(s) to the take out at Tar Landing.

DIRECTIONS:

TO PUT-IN: Pollocksville NCWRC Ramp on the Trent River. Traveling south from New Bern on US 17 into Pollocksville, turn left into park and ramp area just after crossing the Trent River Bridge.

TO TAKE OUT: Tar Landing

Heading south on Hwy 17 from New Bern, turn left into Riverbend on Shoreline Drive. At Town Hall, turn right on Plantation Drive and go to first street on left. Turn left on Gatewood drive and follow around (past stop sign) to Tar Landing Road (1/2 mile). Turn left and continue to end of road. (No restrooms)
