For those planning to day trip or shuttle on a daily basis, plan to be at launch site about 2 hours before departure, unload boat and arrange shuttle with others at site. Note; departure time is 10 a.m. daily except Thursday morning, please be on time for our scheduled daily departures.

Saturday, October 27th

Optional camp at White Oak Campground Friday night, depart from "The Lakes" (10 am) on Saturday for Long Point (13 miles). Shuttle cars to New Bern prior to departure.

Sunday, October 28th

Depart (10am) Longs Point for Cedar Point CG (12 miles)

Monday, October 29th

Lay Day at Cedar Point... Breakfast at Swansboro and day trip explore Huggins and Bear Islands

Tuesday, October 30th

Depart Cedar Point CG (10 am) for Bogue Sound front private property off of Goose Bay Point (9 miles) or spoil Island

Wednesday October 31st

Depart (10 am) for Night at the Aquarium (12 miles). Pizza, program and spend the night at Aquarium

Thursday, November 1st

Depart Aquarium (9 am) for Oyster Point w/ lunch in MHC (16 miles)

Friday, November 2nd

Depart Oyster Point (10 am) for Siddie Fields with a beach bonfire planned for tonight! (16 miles)

Saturday, November 3rd

Depart Siddie Fields (10 am) for Fishers Landing (13 miles)
Pizza delivered tonight at campground???

Sunday, November 4th

Depart Fishers Landing (10 am) for Lawson' Park in New Bern (12 miles)

NOTE:

* It is each participant's responsibility to consider their own abilities and to monitor wind, water and weather conditions.

*Departure times are firm to meet distance and tide predictions.
Please make your shuttles and be prepared to launch on time!

* Facility's:

Long Point (pit toilets only)
Cedar Point: (Shower, Water and flush toilets close by)
Spoil Island (primitive only)
Siddie Fields: may have pit toilet by date of paddle..??
Oyster Point and Fishers Landing (water and pit toilets)

* Camping and others fees TBD

* Arrangements confirmed with Aquarium (same as last year).
Expect cost to be \$25 to \$30 per person includes Pizza dinner (3- 4 slices each) continental breakfast, and programming
