Where: Scott's Creek

Paddle Distance: 5 miles

Trip Difficulty: Easy to difficult depending on the wind and weather on the Neuse River

Skill Requirements: Novice to difficult

Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning for this trip. If you have any doubt, contact your trip leader for advice.

Trip Details: We will *meet at Lawson's Creek Park* at 5 pm so that people will be able to join us after work. We will paddle down the Trent River, under the drawbridge, hug the bank on the Neuse River and down Scott's Creek.

Provisions Needed: A type II or III PFD must be worn and properly secured. Dress appropriately for weather conditions wearing synthetics and in layers. Bring a change of clothes in a dry bag and water.

Launch Time: No later than 5:15

Time on the water: about 2 hours.

Shuttle: Not required
