

SCOTTS CREEK PADDLE

Wednesday - July 18th @ 6:00PM

WHEN: Wednesday July 18, 2007 – 6:00PM

WHERE: Lawson Creek to Scott Creek and return

PADDLE DISTANCE: About 4.3 miles

TRIP DIFFICULTY: ** EASY

SKILL REQUIREMENTS: ** BEGINNER

** Please consider your paddle abilities and weather conditions when planning attend this trip. If you have any doubt, contact your trip leader for advice. TRPC membership not required however applications are available at site.

TRIP DETAILS: Scott Creek: This paddle gives you a good view of the underside of the Neuse River bridge and the man made nature preserve and its wildlife. The real highlight of this trip is the paddle through the tunnels under Highway US 70 and the swampy creek beyond.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: A PFD ideally type II or III must be worn and properly secured, dress warmly wearing synthetics and in layers. Bring a change of clothes in a dry bag and plenty of water

LAUNCH : No later then 6:00PM

TIME ON WATER: 3 hour max. Off the water by 8:00PM

SHUTTLE: Not required.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO:

PUT-IN: Lawson Creek Park

From US 70 By-Pass of New Bern take the Pembroke Exit and head toward downtown New Bern. Turn right within 100 yards of the US 70 overpass into Lawson Creek Park. Go to the boat ramps on the Trent River to launch or the sandy beach at Jacks Island.

TAKE-OUT: SAME AS PUT-IN.
