

TUCKER-GOODWIN CREEK PADDLE
Near Carolina Pines and Slocum Creek
September 27th - SATURDAY

WHEN: SATURDAY, September 27th Launch time 1:30 p.m.

SKILL / DIFFICULTY: **BEGINNER –EASY!!!**

TRIP DETAILS: Join other paddlers (Canoe and Kayak) for a short but enjoyable exploration paddle of Tucker and Goodwin Creeks. Note, this is a very protected paddle area and ideally suited for novice / beginner paddlers. Your launch is from a private landing and please expect to pay a \$3 per car fee. Usually, you can expect little to no boat traffic. The streams are quite narrow and offers protection from the wind for its entire length . Wildlife sightings are quite common along the paddle. This will be a loop type paddle, no shuttle required.

PUT-IN, WHERE and WHEN:

Paul's Landing on Goodwin Creek: Arrive no later then 1:00 p.m. for a 1:30 p.m. launch

Directions to put-in:

Traveling toward Havelock on US70 from New Bern, turn left onto Carolina Pines Blvd (into Carolina Pines). Immediately turn right onto frontage road (at filling station). Go a short distance and turn left on Lewis Farm Road. Follow about 1 mile to Mill Dam Road, turn right at sign to Paul's RV Park and Landing. Follow road to end and landing.

PROVISIONS NEEDED: A type II or III PFD must be worn and properly secured. Bring sunscreen, hat and plenty of water.

TIME ON WATER: No more than 2 hours.
